Every step of the way, we work to Every step of the way, we work to bring communities together through the power of soccer, making lifelong fans of the sport.







MANAGING RISK: NORTH DAKOTA SAFE SOCCER

Ensuring member and participant safety is a role North Dakota Soccer takes seriously. Our number one risk-management objective is to provide a safe environment for players, and with that comes a lot of heavy lifting for club coaches and administrative personnel in the form of required training and education, passing a background check, and tracking/ensuring compliance.

As much as these steps help ensure the player is free from emotional, physical, and sexual abuse, they also serve to better equip and protect the adults working with youth players, as well as the club as an entity.

NORTH DAKOTA SAFE SOCCER INITIATIVES:

- Monitor and ensure member compliance with the SafeSport Act
- Abuse Policy and reporting procedures easily accessible
- Background check protocols enacted annually, with disqualifying issues assessed and then enforced per organization policy.
- Concussion management.
- Access to the most updated U.S. Soccer health and safety initiatives, resources, and protocols.



MANAGING RISK: INSURANCE COVERAGE

We believe that every child should have a safe place to play soccer. Education and awareness are critical components to creating safe and respectful sporting environments, free of abuse and harassment. North Dakota Soccer Association is committed to ensuring everyone has the proper training to protect athletes from all forms of abuse that can occur in sports.

North Dakota Soccer provides its member players insurance coverage for their safety. But member players aren't the only ones covered by an insurance product. At the management level, coverage protects – from putting their personal assets at risk.
